Location: Rosebud, nestled between Rye and Dromana on the Nepean Highway, is part of the Mornington Peninsula which is located just over an hour's drive away from the city, on Melbourne's 'doorstep', and is often described as Melbourne's playground. It is the most popular informal recreation area in Victoria.

Rosebud's commercial centre stretches along one side of about a 2 kilometre length of Point Nepean Road, with some shops separated from this wide thoroughfare by a service road.
